In addition to being the leading CAD software, Autodesk has also pioneered building information modeling (BIM) and 3D data capture and sharing with Building Information Modeling and Web Enabled Construction (BIM WEC). More information about the company can be found at www.autodesk.com. For this article, you will be using an older version of AutoCAD. If you need the most recent version, download it from the Autodesk website. Although AutoCAD may be the most popular choice for CAD users, it is certainly not the only option available for creating computer-aided drafting (CAD) drawings. Another, newer, and perhaps less-well known option is Rhinoceros 3D. At one time, Rhino was

considered a very viable competitor for AutoCAD and the most popular commercial CAD application, but recently, it has taken a backseat to Autodesk's more recently released applications, including AutoCAD LT (release 14). The rest of this article is a comparison of the two popular CAD software applications — AutoCAD and Rhino. AutoCAD vs. Rhino 3D: Building Information Modeling (BIM) With AutoCAD and Rhino, you can use BIM to design 3D buildings. Rhino 3D is much better at 3D modeling than AutoCAD. AutoCAD (with Autodesk Design Review) is an example of a standalone BIM application. It is released as a desktop application that runs on Windows, Linux, and Macintosh computers. It allows users to import and export various BIM models. In addition, it can create 2D and 3D

designs. It can import DWG and DXF files, and it can output in DWG, DWF, DXF, and IFC formats. Rhino 3D is a powerful but expensive, integrated design and construction application. It is available as a desktop application for Windows and Mac computers and as a web app for iPads, iPhones, and other mobile devices. It allows users to create 2D and 3D designs. In addition, it can import and export various BIM models, including 3D Building Information Modeling (BIM). It can import and export various other CAD file formats. Building Information Modeling (BIM) enables buildings to be designed and built in 3D. Since it is a relatively new concept in the world of building design and construction, there
